



Information regarding fine arts competition.

Regarding High School:

#1 Please make sure you have the current 2020AACS Handbook. We will be following the rules from the handbook with a few exceptions. It is available on aacs.org.

#2 There are a few things that we do at the state level that are different than what is done at the national level. At the state level, we offer Choir (25+) as a category, the Algebra 1 test, and Acoustical Guitar. Also, at the state level, instrumental pieces will not have to be memorized. Please make special note that these are **only at the state level.**

#3 Thursday competitions will be Spelling Bee, Bible Memory, Science Fair, Debate and Art entries.

#4 There is no limit on what a student can enter except....

**A student can only enter once for any category.

They cannot be competing against themselves.

**A student can enter no more than 5 art entries

**A student can only compete in only 1 of these three categories - Spelling Bee, Bible Memory and Debate. This is because of scheduling conflicts.

Regarding Junior High:

We will be following the AACS Handbook just like we did last year, however, we will be adjusting some of the rules for the Junior High. All of the adjustments are given below.

- ▶ All timed events will be 2 minutes less than what the AACS Manual says. For example a 10-12 minute performance for a High School student becomes an 8-10 minute performance for a Junior High student.
- ▶ There will be only 1 performance piece for any category
- ▶ Instrumental pieces will not have to be memorized
- ▶ The first 5 rounds of Bible Memory will come from points I - III. Beginning in round 6, questions can come from any point on the outline.
