Wallula Christian Preschool serves children who have met the age requirements set by Kansas public schools.

Children must be the age of the class you wish to enroll in on or before August 31st in order to start the school year. Each class will have a minimum of 6 children and a maximum of 12 children per class. Children must be toilet trained, have a medical physical examination and have all immunizations up to date before attending classes.

Registration Fee: An \$85 per child, or \$110 per family, nonrefundable fee is due at the time of registration. This reserves a spot for your child(ren). This fee is used for daily snacks and a WCP t-shirt for each student. This fee is paid each school year.

Tuition: Tuition is to be paid in full for the year prior to the first day of school or in nine payments (first payment due before the first day of school, then the first Tuesday school is in session September through April). No financial adjustments are made for student absences or family vacations. A 10% discount is given for tuition paid in full for the year or to a second (or third) child enrolled. The discounts cannot be combined.
