CORE: Read Jonah 3

1. What does God command Jonah to do in verse 1, and how is this different from Jonah's response in chapter 1?
2. Why do you think Jonah obeys God the second time around? What might have changed in him?
3. What stands out to you about how quickly the people of Nineveh respond to Jonah's message? Why do you think that is?
4. How does the outcome in Jonah 3 contrast with what Jonah might have expected or wanted?

5. Why is it significant that God gives Jonah a second chance to obey? What does this say about how God works with us in our failures?

6. Can you think of a time when you resisted God's calling but eventually obeyed? What helped you come around?

7. How does the Ninevites' response challenge our assumptions about who is "too far gone" for God's mercy?

8. Why is repentance such a powerful response to hearing God's Word?

9. How do you respond when God shows mercy to someone you think doesn't deserve it?

10. Where do you sense God calling you to take a step of obedience, even if it's uncomfortable?
