And the Golden Ladle goes to ... Sue Burton!

With 13 great choices, picking just one was hard for many. But ultimately, Sue Burton's **Slow Cooker Creamy Tortellini Soup** came in the 2024 winner!

"I chose this soup because it has become a friend and family favorite, and I'm a huge fan of most anything Italian," Burton said. "I was incredibly surprised by the win since the competition was so wonderful. We have many great cooks in our church. We are blessed."

Ingredients

- 1 pound ground Italian sausage, browned
- 1 onion, chopped
- 2 large carrots, chopped
- 2 stalks celery, chopped
- 4 garlic cloves, minced
- 1 tablespoon Italian seasoning
- 2 teaspoons beef bouillon powder (or chicken)
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 4 cups chicken broth
- 1/4 cup cornstarch dissolved in 1/4 cup water
- 36 ounces half-n-half
- 1 12-oz package 3-cheese tortellini, frozen
- 5 cups fresh baby spinach
- 1 cup milk

Instructions

Place browned sausage, onion, carrots, celery, garlic, Italian seasoning, beef bouillon powder, salt and broth in a 6-quart/litre slow cooker bowl. Cover and cook on high for 4 hours or low for 7 hours.

Uncover and skim any fat sitting on top of the soup with a spoon; discard. Stir in cornstarch mixture and half-n-half. Add tortellini; mix well. Cover again and cook on HIGH heat setting for an additional 45 minutes until the soup has thickened and the tortellini is soft and cooked through.

Add spinach, pressing leaves down to completely submerse in liquid. Cover again for 5 to 10 minutes until leaves are wilted.

Add milk in 1/3 cup increments as needed to reach your desired thickness and consistency; salt and pepper to taste.

Serve with crusty warm bread.
