Ideas on How to Reduce and Reuse

Think Green Before You Shop

Combine several small trips into one big trip to help reduce pollutants and greenhouse gasses.

Reduce Your Food Waste

Shop smart. Buy what you need, compost food scraps, and donate unused food to food banks or shelters. It's a great way to reduce your environmental impact.

Reuse or Repurpose Items

Donate old clothing, reuse cloth grocery bags and containers to prevent waste.

Buy Used Items

This cuts back on the emissions produced by manufacturers and reduced the number of items sent to landfills.

Donate Items You Don't Plan To Use

"But it's still good!" Only if you're using it. If you donate it, it will be good for someone else!

Buy Products Made of Recycled Content

Check labels to see if a product or its packaging is made from recycled materials.

Know Before You Throw

Check with your local recyclers to know what and how they accept recyclables. Many people think you have to sort your items — but that's not always the case.




