### Our MMDC Volunteers Thank First UMC for Support and Assistance!

While there was definitely plenty of work, reportedly there was also much joy experienced on the First UMC-Columbus's 2023 Mission Trip to Chatham, Illinois earlier this month.

"It affected our hearts deeply to see so much love in action," said **Dee Kinkaid**, one of our First UMC participants. "We got to observe the blessing and send-off of an entire semitrailer full of supplies to Guatemala. That shipment alone was worth nearly \$150,000"

Participants spent three days repairing bikes (12), building desks (9), packing bed packs (200), assembling personal dignity kits (100), counting vitamin packs to include with meal packs, counting donated items into inventory (baby sweaters, baby layette blankets, hygiene cloth bags, diapers, dust masks, quilts of love, girl outfits) and taping the lids of shampoo and other liquid items shut for transport and compiling information packets for distribution at the North Central Bishop's Assembly.

Our congregation contributed the following items to the trip: 11 laundry detergent jugs, 14 dish washing soaps, 6 Clorox cleaners, 3 tubes Desitin ointment, 22 rulers, 13 toothpastes, 45 colored pencil packs, 20 child scissors, 17 flannel pieces, 25 wash clothes, 12 hand towels, 51 crayon packs, 20 combs, 25 spiral notebooks, 2 letter openers, 8 sponges, 12 quilts of love, 11 girl outfits, 1 treadle sewing machine with cabinet, 1 portable sewing machine, \$250 from GROWMen, \$500 from UMM and other monetary gifts given by individuals.

All interested youth in Grades 8-12 and adult chaperones aged 25 and older can register now. There is a \$50 nonrefundable deposit due at sign up.




#### Youth Homemade Pie Sales
