We were saddened to hear of the passing of Bill Ritter's mother, Elizabeth Ritter Matschullat, who died August 31. Her funeral will be tomorrow, Sept. 6 at Pleasanton UMC at 11 AM, with visitation beginning at 9:30 AM.

Each year the Great Plains Conference holds Orders and Fellowship — a big gathering event for all Great Plains UMC clergy members. This year's Orders and Fellowship will be held at the Younes Center North in Kearney, NE from Monday, October 23 through Wednesday, October 25. The conference is looking for people who are willing and able to provide quality child care for children ages 6 months through 6 years.

Childcare workers will be paid \$15.00 per hour, and will have to fill out a W-9 form. (If someone cannot receive compensation due to immigration status, a gift card could possibly be given in place of compensation, depending on conference policy and/ or approval.)

The conference will provide hotel rooms for hires who work both days and live at least 50 miles away from Kearney.

Other Important Information

- Must be Safe Gatherings Certified. If not, the conference will pay the fee for you to take the SG course. (In the event that someone is not able to become certified due to immigration status, they will be paired with one or more workers who are.)
- Curriculum, toys, games, puzzles, etc. are provided.
- Childcare staff will help children with lunch. (Provided by the hotel. Childcare staff will also receive lunch.)
- ► Staff members can be youth, as long as they are 16 years of age or older and Safe Gatherings Certified.
- Any helpers who would be available the on first day (Monday, Oct. 23) to assist with setting up the childcare rooms would be greatly appreciated.


