All Platte County residents should have received an Early Voting Ballot Application last week. If you did not receive one call the Platte County Election Commissioner's office at 402-563-4908.

Dates to Know

Friday, October 23- Applications must be received by the Election Office no later than 6PM CT.

Monday, September 28 - Voting Ballots will begin getting mailed out.

Friday, October 16 - Last day to register to vote, in person at the Election Office before 6PM OR online by midnight.

Election Day November 3

Vote in person at assigned precinct. Voting ballots must be received in Election Office by 8PM either by mail or placed in ballot box by door at Courthouse (to be sure your ballot is received in time mail early)
