In John 15 Jesus says, "I have told you these things that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete." Yes! We've come into the middle of a thought because we need to know what Jesus has just told them. Well, he said his followers are to love one another as I have loved you. How could keeping his command to love others bring us joy?

One thing: we would have no doubt we are doing what he asked us to do—that's called obedience.

And maybe one more thing: there is a certain kind of satisfaction when we get outside of ourselves (or get over ourselves) and think about or care about someone besides us.

IT all adds up to God's joy taking hold of our lives and being expressed in tangible ways.

I wonder if John 15 might have influenced John Wesley in some way when he penned these words to the early Methodists:

Do all the good you can, in all the ways you can, to all the souls you can, in every place you can, at all the times you can, with all the zeal you can, as long as ever you can.

Plant some seeds of joy in the lives of others around you. Then watch how much the Lord grows joy in your life! Bring Your fulfilling joy, Lord! Amen.
