It's finally VBS Month! After lots of prep and planning it's time to share the love of Jesus with kids at VBS the week of July 14-18, for children entering Kindergarten - entering 6th grade. Our theme this year is Magnified! Discovering the Bigness of God in the Smallest of Things. T-shirts are in! Catch me before church on Wednesday nights in the gym or Sundays after church in the nursery to pick yours up. After camp, I will be hitting the decorations hard the two weeks leading up to VBS. Will send out Remind messages as to when help will be needed. Thanks to everyone who has been making decorations up til now and a shout out to Hopewell, FBC Selmer, and Mt. Herman for sharing their decorations after they were done with them! We will pass along to another church to use when we are finished too. I may need a couple of more people to work registration. So if you have a few hours each morning to spare that week, it would be most appreciated. Even if you can't work that week, you can still be praying for God to move in the hearts of children so that they would know HIM and receive His free gift of salvation!

VBS Family Night will be Friday July 18 from 6-8pm. We will have a short program in the sanctuary, followed by a light meal and party jumper water slides out back after dinner.

In Sunday School this month (Sundays at 9am), we will continue learning about King David. After protecting his family's flock of sheep, David was called into a roll of shepherding God's flock- the nation of Israel. He showed his trust in God through defeating Goliath, his heart for mercy by sparing Saul, and his willingness to put God's plans above his own. But King David was still a broken human who gave in to his sinful desires. Yet, God showed his love and grace by forgiving and restoring David upon his repentance. Our big picture question of the month is: Is anything greater than God? No, God is greater than everything. Our key passage of the month is: Lord, there is no one like you. You are great; Your name is great in power. Jeremiah 10:6. We invite all kids 6th grade and under to join us each week as we study God's Word in chronological order and memorize scripture.

Wednesday nights in Journey Kids at 6pm, we "travel" to Panama in the Caribbean Islands. As we "visit" there, we will see it's crystal blue waters and exciting marine life, learn about its many countries, and meet Carlos and Lily Llambes, mission's catalysts with the International Mission Board (IMB) who helped the churches in the Caribbean tell people they are loved so much by God!
