The Triumphal Entry

21 When they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage at the Mount of Olives, Jesus then sent two disciples, 2 telling them, "Go into the village ahead of you. At once you will find a donkey tied there with her colt. Untie them and bring them to me. 3 If anyone says anything to you, say that the Lord needs them, and he will send them at once."

4 This took place so that what was spoken through the prophet might be fulfilled:

5 Tell Daughter Zion,

"See, your King is coming to you, gentle, and mounted on a donkey, and on a colt, the foal of a donkey."^[a]

6 The disciples went and did just as Jesus directed them. 7 They brought the donkey and the colt; then they laid their clothes on them, and he sat on them.

8 A very large crowd spread their clothes on the road; others were cutting branches from the trees and spreading them on the road. 9 Then the crowds who went ahead of him and those who followed shouted:

Hosanna to the Son of David!

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!

Hosanna in the highest heaven!

10 When he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was in an uproar, saying, "Who is this?" 11 The crowds were saying, "This is the prophet Jesus from Nazareth in Galilee."

Last month in Sunday School (Sundays at 9am), we completed our study of the Old Testament and will begin March with the study of the New Testament for the next year. After 400 years of silence from God, at last - Jesus - the promised Messiah, had arrived as a baby. As Jesus grew, He found favor with God and people. The incarnation - the act of taking on flesh - set the stage for Jesus to be the all-sufficient sacrifice for the sins of the world! Our Big Picture Question is: Who is Jesus? Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, who came to earth to save us. The verse we will memorize is: John 3:16 - For God loved the world in this way: He gave His one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life. Now would be a great time to join our class since we are starting the life of Jesus in the New Testament! All ages for kids meet in the Children's Education Suite.

TeamKid is rolling right along this semester. We will continue studying the different names of Jesus: Compassionate One, Sender, One to Come, Lawgiver, Sower, and Son of God, this semester. We were so excited to be back after the ice storm!

Do you love kids and worshipping God? I could use a volunteer to help with the children's choir on Wednesday nights from 5:30-6. It's hard to manage 30 kids by myself. We are learning some Easter music and speaking parts to share the Gospel with the church and community at the end of April.

This month in Journey Kids, kids will "travel" to Texas and learn about missionary Dexter Laureano, who founded a basketball ministry called Redeemer Sports in a predominately Filipino culture. Kids will learn all about the culture and do lots of basketball activities. Our Bible study will be about Paul, who encouraged the Corinthians to "train hard." Kids will focus on training to be good disciples of Christ. Our verse will be, "Now everyone who competes exercises self-control in everything. They do it to receive a perishable crown, but we receive an imperishable crown." 1 Corinthians 9:25. I have loved having Christian Aid Ministries on our campus in February. Kids have seen first-hand what we talk about every Wednesday night - about others who travel to share Jesus and meet community needs. They have for sure been a blessing to our community with the help of debris clean up after Ice Storm Fern. As of this writing, they have had about 400 requests for help and so far, have served about half of them. They will be here for a few more weeks.
