Children News

We had a great family day at Wildwood last month! Sixty-six of us enjoyed the most beautiful fall day with lots of fun for the kids! Thanks to all who attended!

In TeamKid (1st-6th), we are studying the life of Jesus as we journey through the 4 Gospel books, which tell us about who Jesus is and why He came. They will explore each book's theme and purpose and learn how each account of the same story seamlessly weaves different details together to share the good news of Jesus and the Kingdom of God. We feed the kids a snack upon arrival, play a large group game or two, then half will go to Bible study while the other half has free time and then we switch. Dinner is served at 5pm, with music to follow at 5:30. This year the kids will be learning new praise and worship songs as well as practicing for their Christmas program, The Wonder of Christmas. Go ahead and mark your calendars for Wednesday night Dec 10 to hear the kids sing and share about the birth of our Savior!

On Wednesday nights from 6-7pm in Journey Kids (1st-6th), we are "traveling" to the state of Maine to learn how missionary David Carey, a hospice chaplain, ministers to senior adults and those who are near the end of their life. Kids will learn how they can be sure they have eternal life if they trust in Jesus.

On Wednesday, Nov 5, we will be packing shoeboxes in Building B at 6pm. If any adults would like to come help, feel free to join us. We have 60 to pack. If you are packing a shoebox on your own, please return it by Sunday Nov. 16 so we can gather all the shoeboxes to drop off at Cornerstone in Savannah that week.

We do offer a Preschool and Kindergarten class (Mission Friends) on Wednesday nights from 6-7pm in the preschool area.

Last month in Sunday School (Sundays at 9am), we learned how God let the Northern Kingdom of Israel be destroyed by Assyria because they wouldn't turn from sin. This month, we will learn that the Southern Kingdom of Judah experienced the reign of both good and evil kings Yet, the people's allegiance was divided between the worship of God and the idols of foreign nations. God sent prophets to warn them too, but they didn't listen. He disciplined them by sending them into captivity in Babylon with the promise that one day they would get to return home.
