Message:

Baptism, speaking in tongues, and miracles were key in the apostles doctrine and ministry. Baptism in Jesus Name was so important that Paul re-baptized those who were baptized into John. Receiving the Holy Spirit with speaking in other tongues was greatly emphasized by the laying on of hands. The power of God was so strong that demons and disease could not stand against cloths sent from Paul. These doctrines and supernatural experiences are for the church today!
