Christmas Poinsettias

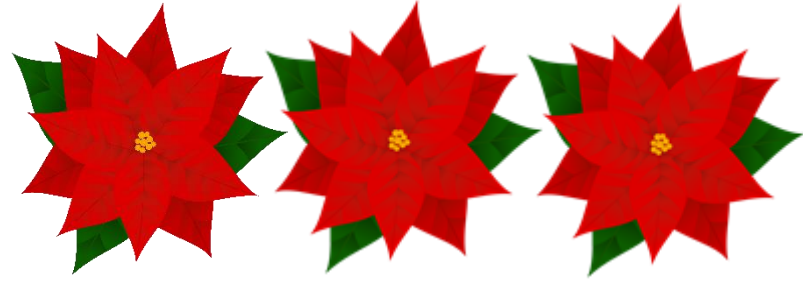
