General Policies

- Please bring your child to the classroom and pick them up each day.
- If your child is sick or absent, please call the Preschool and let the teacher know.
- If your child is sick please keep them home.
 - **"Sick Kid Rule of Thumb"**
 - 100 degree temp or higher
 - vomiting or diarrhea within 24 hours
 - draining eyes
 - oozing sore
 - anything contagious
- If your child is seriously hurt at school we will call you. For minor injuries we will send home an "Ouch Report". If you can't be reached we will call your emergency contact.
- Our Preschool follows Longview School District's elementary school closures due to inclement weather. If they are CLOSED, we are CLOSED. If they are on a 2 hour delay, we will be CLOSED.
