### Special Events\*:

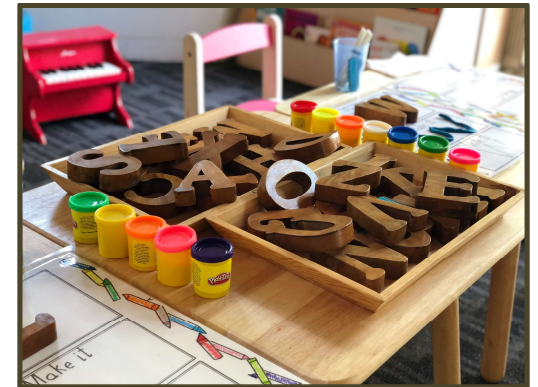
- When we go on fieldtrips we use the church bus or vans and have a driver with a CDL license.

## Communication

- We use the free ClassDojo app for our main mode of communication with you, as well as periodically posting on our Facebook page.
- ClassDojo allows us as staff to communicate with parents individually and as a whole class.
- We also like to post pictures of our activities throughout the day or use it to remind parents of certain activities.
- A monthly newsletter will be provided each month with our schedule and any other pertinent events.

## Tuition

Monthly Tuition (due by the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month)  
3's- \$160      4's- \$200

There will be a \$30 NSF fee for all returned checks.

- Your tuition payment reserves your child's spot in the preschool whether they are present or not.
- Receipts for tuition and other payments will be sent via email.
- Online payments can be made on our website. There is a convenience fee attached when using a card online.

## General Policies

- Please bring your child to the classroom and pick them up each day.
- If your child is sick or absent, please call or communicate via ClassDojo the Preschool and let the teacher know.
- If your child is sick please keep them home.
  - **"Sick Kid Rule of Thumb"**
    - 100 degree temp or higher
    - vomiting or diarrhea within 24 hours
    - draining eyes
    - oozing sore
    - anything contagious
- If your child is seriously hurt at school we will call you. For minor injuries we will send home an "Ouch Report". If you can't be reached we will call your emergency contact.
- Our Preschool *generally* follows Longview School District's elementary school closures due to inclement weather. If they are CLOSED, we are CLOSED. If they are on a 2 hour delay, we will be CLOSED.
- **COVID-19 Policies** are included on registration form. These policies will need to be acknowledged prior to beginning our program.
