Special Events

- When we go on fieldtrips we use a church bus and are driven by a licensed CDL bus driver.
- Our Preschool emphasizes the Christian message. Therefore, we do not participate in Halloween activities. At Christmas and Easter we focus on the Biblical message. We will not use Santa Claus or the Easter Bunny.
- At Christmas both the 3's and 4's will share a Christmas Program with their families.
- At the end of the year we celebrate the children's achievements at a 3's Spring Program and a 4's Graduation Ceremony.

Fieldtrips

Several fieldtrips are planned throughout the year. Parents may join us on our adventures after passing a Washington State Background Check. Forms will be available at the beginning of the school year.

Snacks

At the beginning of each month your child's teacher will hang the "Snack Tree" outside their door. Each parent is asked to take a snack slip, purchase the item, and return it to school the following day or as requested.

Birthdays

Your child's teacher will give you the option of providing snack on or around your child's birthday so that your child can share their special day with their Preschool friends. All snacks must be commercially prepared.

"Sick Kid Rule of Thumb"

- 100 degree temp or higher
- Vomiting or diarrhea within 24 hours
- Draining eyes
- Oozing sore
- Anything contagious

For minor injuries we will send home an "ouch" report. If your child is seriously hurt at school we will call you. If you can't be reached we will call your emergency contact.

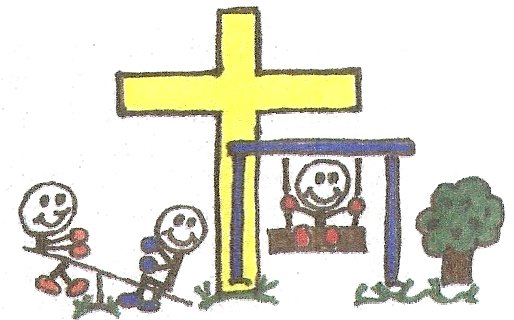
School Closure Policy

Welcome to Calvary Community Preschool

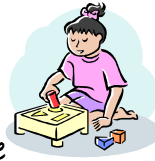
