



PLANTING GUIDE

WHEN YOU PLANT YOUR SPROUT PENCILS, PLEASE FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW TO GET THE BEST RESULT:



1. Use a pot with a drainage hole in the bottom. Place it on a saucer and fill with moist potting soil.



2. Plant at a 30-degree angle with seed capsule only covered in soil.



3. Water often in saucer to keep moist.



4. Place the pot in natural light but avoid direct sunlight. A temperature of 20°C/68°F is ideal.













5. Within 1-4 weeks, fresh plants will sprout.

Common name		Latin name	Germination time	Difficulty	Growing tips
Sunflower*		<i>Helianthus annuus</i>	7-14 days	Easy	Start indoor in the spring. Plant in garden after last frost.
Daisy		<i>Bellis perennis</i>	10-15 days	Easy	Start indoor in the spring. Plant in greenhouse or garden after last frost. Flower blooms year after.
Carnation		<i>Dianthus barbatus</i>	10-15 days	Easy	Start indoor in the spring. Plant in greenhouse or garden after last frost. Flower blooms year after.
Forget me not		<i>Myosotis sylvatica</i>	14-21 days	Medium	Start indoor in the spring. Plant in greenhouse or garden after last frost. Flower blooms year after.
Basil		<i>Ocimum basilicum</i>	6-10 days	Easy	Start indoor all of the year. Can be kept indoor all year around or plant in greenhouse after frost.
Thyme		<i>Thymus vulgaris</i>	14-25 days	Easy	Start indoor in the spring. Plant in greenhouse or garden after last frost.
Sage		<i>Salvia officinalis</i>	14-25 days	Easy	Start indoor in the spring. Plant in greenhouse or garden after last frost.
Coriander		<i>Coriandrum sativum</i>	8-12 days	Easy	Start indoor in the spring. Plant in greenhouse or garden after last frost.
Chia		<i>Salvia hispanica</i>	10-21 days	Medium	Start indoor in the spring. Plant in greenhouse or garden after last frost.
Cherry tomato*		<i>Solanum lycopersicum</i>	8-10 days	Easy	Start indoor in the spring. Plant in greenhouse or garden after last frost.
