

This Week's Prayer Focus: Pratt

Mission Focus: Despite the pandemic, our congregation has been able to make a difference for others in the area and improve their wellbeing. Twenty low-income children receive a home-cooked meal to-go on Wednesday nights through our C.R.E.W. (Christians Ready Equipped and Willing) program. Twenty-four children in the community remain connected to mentors through our Eagle Wings Mentoring Ministry, sometimes having to do so through mail, phone calls, and texts. Twenty senior citizens receive Friendship meal lunches delivered by our volunteers every Thursday. Eighty people enjoy our volunteers' desserts once a month at the local soup kitchen. The congregation sends financial support and donates items to the local food bank and The Hope Center, a "one-stop shop" on Main Street that provides resources to people in need. We donate artificial Christmas trees to an elementary school for those families that would like one, as well as new children's sweatpants. To a high school we donate easy-to-prepare, non-perishable food for hungry students. If Westminster Woods camp reopens, Pratt Presbyterian Church is likely to continue to take care of as much of the cost as possible for all the children we enroll.
