

LET'S TALK ABOUT IT

What is a promise?

Have you ever had to wait a long time for something that was promised to you? What did waiting feel like?

What did God promise Abraham?

Did God do what He said He was going to do?



You'll Need:

- Printed Star Template (on heavy cardstock)
- Crayons, Markers, Paint, or Colored Pencils (and any other supplies you'd like to use to decorate the stars).
- Cardboard
- Scissors
- Glue
- Yarn or Ribbon
- Hole Punch
- Stick



Instructions:

- 1 Print the star template on cardstock. Use scissors to cut around the star.
- 2 Trace around the star template onto cardboard. Repeat 5 times. Use scissors to cut out the stars.
- 3 Decorate the stars using markers, crayons, colored pencils, or any other supplies you'd like to use.
- Use a hole punch to punch a hole at the top of each star.
- String a piece of ribbon through the hole and tie a knot to secure the ribbon.
- **6** Repeat until all of the stars have ribbon and then tie the other end of each ribbon to the stick to create the star mobile.
- 7 Attach the verse printable to the middle of the stick with glue. Hang up your finished mobile and each time you look at it be reminded that God is faithful and He will do what He says.



STAR FINGERPRINT CARDS

You'll Need:

- Star fingerprint card + star template
- Cardstock and construction paper
- Washable Paint
- Glue • Optional: Washi/Painters Tape

JUST A LITTLE REMINDER THAT GOD IS FAITHFUL YOU VERY MUCH!

Instructions:

- 🕜 Print the star fingerprint card + star template on cardstock and cut out both rectangles on the grey solid line.
- Cut out the star template (where the dashed line is) and place the rectangle on top of the card (You can secure the template with washi tape/painters tape on the ends to assure that it doesn't move while your child is painting).
- 3 Invite your child to dip their finger in the paint and then press it down inside of the star. Repeat with as many finger prints as you'd like.
- 4 Once dry, carefully remove the template to reveal the fingerprint star.
- 5 Fold a piece of construction paper in half and attach the finished star print to the front with glue to make a card. Deliver or mail the cards to encourage and remind others that God is faithful.

CINNAMON STAR CHIPS SNACK

You'll Need:

- Flour Tortillas
- Parchment Paper
- 2 TBS Melted Butter Star Cookie Cutter
- 1/2 Cup Sugar
- Baking Sheet
- 2 TBS Cinnamon



Instructions:

- 1 Preheat your oven to 400 degrees.
- Use a star shaped cookie cutter to cut the tortillas into stars.
- 3 Add the cut tortillas to a large bowl and pour the melted butter on top. Stir until all of the tortillas are covered with melted butter.
- 👍 In a bowl mix the sugar and cinnamon together. Cover both sides of each tortilla in the cinnamon sugar mixture.
- 5 Place the tortillas on a parchment paper covered baking sheet.
- 6 Bake for 10–12 minutes then flip them over and bake until cripsy.
- Remove from the oven and serve. These chips are delicious by themselves. or you can serve them with mixed fruit or a fruit salsa.

WAITING ON A PROMISE ACTIVITY

You'll Need:

- Bandana
- Objects for an obstacle course

Instructions:

Sometimes obeying God means waiting on His timing and trusting that He knows where He's leading us.

- 1 For this activity, first set up a small obstacle course and then blindfold one person. The other person is a guide.
- Carefully guide the blindfolded person through the obstacle course and then guide them to sit down on a chair. Tell them that you will be right back and you promise to give them something when you return, but they need to wait here in the chair until you come back. (Either remain quiet or leave the room for a little bit and then come back with a special treat (fruit snacks, lollipop, popsicle, etc.)
- 3 After waiting for a little while, tell the blindfolded person that they can take the blindfold off and then give them the special surprise.

If your child doesn't wait in the chair and leave the blindfold on you can ask them why they didn't wait for you to come back? Did they not believe you were going to do what you had promised?

Discuss it! We can always count on God to walk with us and care for us, even when what He is asking us to do feels scary. What did it feel like to be blindfolded? Did you like not knowing where you were going? Did you trust the person leading you? Isn't it amazing that God is faithful and we can always trust where He is leading us?

Sometimes obeying God means waiting on His timing. What did waiting in the chair feel like? Did you trust that I was going to come back when I said I would? We can trust in God's timing, even when it might feel like we have to wait a long time.

Thank God together that He is faithful and that we can wait on His timing and trust that He knows where He's leading us.
