

Direct Giving



What is the St. Agnes Parish Direct Giving Program?

Direct Giving at St. Agnes presents an opportunity to donate to the Parish directly from your checking or savings account. Similar to envelope giving, the donation is recorded to your giving record and is included in the year-end contribution statement you receive from the parish.

When do the withdrawals occur?

Your Direct Giving will take place once a month. You will have the option of the withdrawal occurring on the 1st or 15th of each month. If either of these days are a weekend or holiday, the withdrawal will be done on the next business day that month.

What kind of accounts can be used to make donations?

You may have Direct Giving withdrawn from a checking or savings account.

What donations can be made via Direct Giving?

You can designate your donation to Sacrificial Giving, Repairs & Replacements or Future Needs.

What happens to the offering envelopes that are received bi-monthly?

You will continue to receive the envelope packets in the mail which will include all of the special envelopes that are distributed throughout the year. The weekly sacrificial envelopes have a notation "I Give Electronically" on them that you may use if you desire.

How does the Direct Giving Program benefit St. Agnes Parish?

The electronic collection provides the parish with a consistent level of revenue. Direct Giving will also reduce the effort necessary to process the envelopes, checks and cash for weekly sacrificial offerings.

What benefit is the Direct Giving Program to St. Agnes Parishioners?

You will not need to write checks or place cash in your weekly envelope. You will be consistently supporting the Parish even if you are out-of-town for the weekend. You will save postage if you currently mail your weekly contribution.

How do I get started with Direct Giving?

You can begin Direct Giving by completing the St. Agnes Parish ACH Debit Authorization form. Return the form, and a voided check if that is your account option, to the St. Agnes Parish office. The complete directions are on the back of the form.
