Ministry Guidelines

- Masks— Required for Volunteers and children in 3rd-6th grade. Preschool-2nd grade recommended.
- We will be limiting access our Sunday School area to the public and will operate with our new check-in system (with temp checks) that will be introduced.
- Frequent hand washing and hand sanitizing while children are on campus.
- Each room will be disinfected after each service where children are present.
- Classroom ratios and space of our children's ministry room will also be considered.
- Supplies will be pre-prepared for each child. No sharing materials.
- No outside food will be allowed in Children's Ministry for the time being.
- Please abide by our current FBC Kids health policy and do not bring children who show any illness symptoms. Also, let us know if your child is medicated for any ailment so that we can properly care for that child.

Please note that this is our current plan to reopen our Children's Ministry at FBC Crossett. These plans are flexible and subject to change at any time. Our main concern is for the health and safety of our children, families, and volunteers.
