2019 DISTRICT-WIDE SERVICE PROJECT

This year, the District-Wide Projects committee is asking each church in the district to collect supplies for 5 CWS Hygiene kits, including the \$2 per kit for shipping/handling, and bring to District Conference in September. The items that need to be included in the kits, as well as basic instructions, are listed below. For questions about the project, contact Karen Odiorne or Theresa Sites.

CWS HYGIENE KIT SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- One hand towel measuring approximately 15" x 28" to 16" x 32" (no fingertip, bath, dish towel or micro-fiber)
- One washcloth
- One wide-tooth comb removed from the package
- One finger nail or toe nail clipper removed from the package
- One bath size bar of soap in the wrapper
- One toothbrush in the package
- Ten standard size Band-aids

All items need to fit inside a one-gallon plastic zipper closure bag. Remove the excess air from the bag and seal before boxing. Do not add any extra items or toothpaste. A tube of extended expiration date toothpaste will be added to each Hygiene Kit just prior to its journey.
