Relational/Invisible Questions to Answer

Kindergarten-1st: Do I Have Your Attention? – In Kindergarten and 1st grade, a child craves adult attention and approval. When adults demonstrate interests in a kid's progress, kids **IMPROVE ABILITIES**.

2nd-3rd: Do I Have What It Takes? – In 2nd and 3rd grade, a kid wants to know their abilities compare with peers. When adults praise a kid's persistence and effort, kids **BROADEN COMPETENCE**.

4th-5th: Do I Have Friends? In 4th and 5th grade, a kid begins to prioritize friends in a new way. When adults make introductions and include peers, kids **DEVELOP FRIENDSHIPS**.
