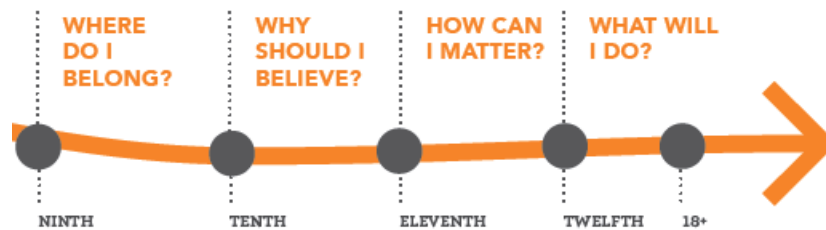

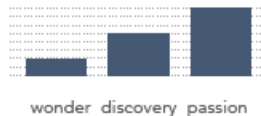

Relational/Invisible Questions to Answer
