

July 7-16 — The Appalachian Mountains, Tennessee

MountainTOP is a service project ministry designed to promote cultural exchange experiences for adults and youth. Participants will work with local mountain families doing minor work to their homes. We will grow in fellowship and in our relationship with Christ as we work hard and have fun.

 - (Through mission endowment, The Grove offsets the full cost for chaperones this summer.)
 - Participants need approximate \$150 in spending money.
- ⇒ Trip Preparation
 - Plan to attend the following meeting at The Grove for trip preparation and paperwork completion: May 20, 10 am and July 6, 7 pm-8 pm.


