

## CURRICULUM

Our curriculum, based on the Early Childhood Indicators of Progress: Minnesota's Early Learning Standards (ECIPs), meets each child's emotional, social, intellectual, physical and spiritual areas of developmental needs for each age group. The child-focused curriculum emphasizes

- development of positive self-esteem,
- eagerness to learn,
- cooperation and respect for others.

It intentionally considers the needs of the whole child based on what he or she should learn, how best to learn it while building on current knowledge and abilities.

Children receive the opportunity to learn and develop through exploration and play. With our small class sizes, teachers work with individual children and small groups on specific skills.



Materials and resources promote interest and encourage the child to explore, experiment, and learn. Activities help children improve reasoning, and problem solving skills, abilities to get along with others, language and life skills like independence.

Daily class schedules vary by age and include rest time for infant and toddler classes.

## CONFERENCES

We schedule parent-teacher conferences in the fall and spring. The teachers welcome the opportunity to discuss individual concerns at any time.

## GATHERING

Once a week, The Grove United Methodist Church Minister to Families with Children leads an inter-denominational "Gathering Time". She presents value lessons through music, stories, and discussions. A short prayer concludes each Gathering Time. Students say grace before meals.

## OPEN HOUSE

We hold open house for children and parents in September at the school. You and your child will have an opportunity to meet the teachers and visit the classrooms.



## REGISTRATION

Registered children are assigned to a class based upon their age as of September 1.

New students may register for the following school year from December through Martin Luther King Day for initial openings. We accept telephone and in-person registrations.

A waiting list for any class openings that may occur during the school year.

We require a \$75 non-refundable fee with each registration once a student has been guaranteed a spot in the program.

Our school closely follows South Washington County School District #833 for holidays and inclement weather schedules.

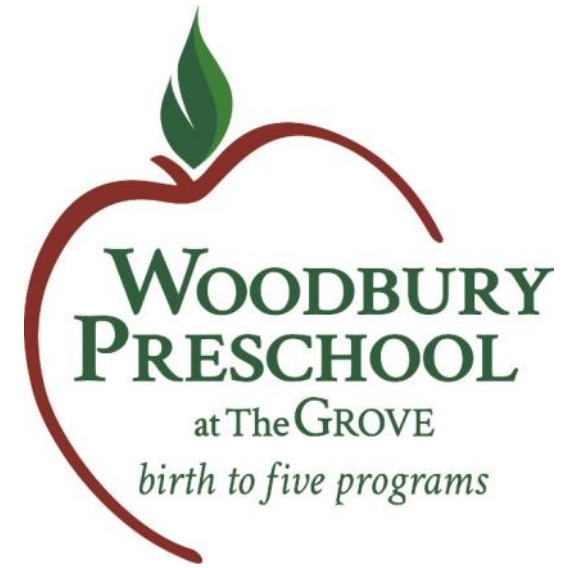
