THE CONSISTENCY OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST

⁷ Remember those who rule over you, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow, considering the outcome of *their* conduct. ⁸ Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. ⁹ Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines. For *it is* good that the heart be established by grace, not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them.

Hebrews 13:7-9 NKJV

Today more than ever we live in a world of changes; from fashion to weather to technology. We have advanced from crank phones to dial phones to touchtone and now the smart phone. These changes are sometimes for the better and sometimes for the worse. But our Lord and Saviour does not change, HE IS CONSISTENT.

JESUS WAS CONSISTENT IN HIS SACRIFICE FOR MANKIND (HEBREWS 2:9): Jesus died for everyone — men, women, all races and socio-economic levels. In order for Christ to sacrifice for us He had to be crucified.

JESUS WAS CONSISTENT IN HIS SUFFERING (HEBREWS 12:2-3): Abraham, the friend of God could not qualify nor could David, the man after God's own heart. Only Jesus qualified to complete the work of salvation and He was consistent in enduring the suffering of the cross, (reference John 19:30). Jesus endured the pain of the cross. He did not lose heart or grow weary of the suffering.

JESUS IS CONSISTENT AS OUR GREAT HIGH PRIEST (HEBREWS 9:24): He appears in the presence of God on our behalf. He is not like earthly priests who come and go, live and die. He is permanent and unchangeable (Hebrews 7:24)

THE CONSISTENCY OF CHRIST SHOULD MOTIVATE AND ENCOURAGE US TO BE CONSISTENT:

Bible Doctrine (Hebrews 13:9, 2 Timothy 4:3-4, 2:15)

Methods for Giving

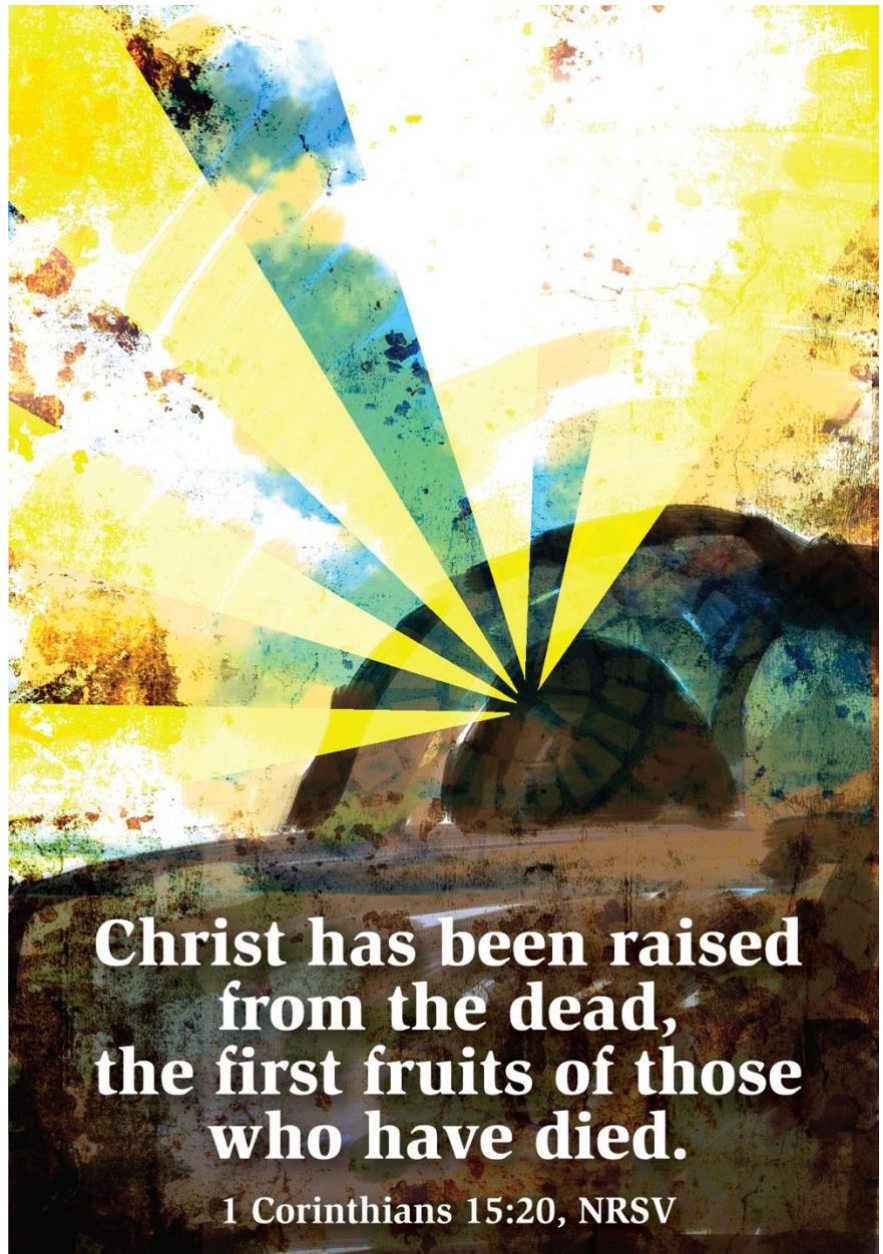
