1 John 5:14-15

New Testament confidence in prayer

14 And we are confident that he hears us whenever we ask for anything that pleases him. 15 And since we know he hears us when we make our requests, we also know that he will give us what we ask for. NLT

KJV – Confidence

Pray with confidence!

Pray according to God's will!

Have the assurance of being heard!

Confidence brings rest and peace.

John summarizes our confidence: asking according to His will, He hears and grants our requests.

5 And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

Luke 11:1-3 KJV

1 And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.

2 And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven,

Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.

3 Give us day by day our daily bread.

4 And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.

Didache 8:1-3

"But let not your fasts be with the hypocrites, for they fast on the second and fifth days of the week; but you shall fast on the fourth day and on the day of preparation (Friday)."

"And you shall not pray as the hypocrites, but as the Lord commanded in His Gospel, thus pray: 'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.'" (followed by the Lord's Prayer)

"For of the spiritual fast, you shall fast twice in the week, and wash yourself before your fasts, as you are able."
