In John 15, the word **abide** is used 11 times. It's synonymous with **remain**.

a bide: To accept or act in accordance with something (keep to, hold to, conform to, adhere to, stick to, stand by)

Love is **clearly** the **badge** and main **attribute** of Christianity ---> After all, God is LOVE!
