This week we want you to reflect on the words of the Bible. Take some time and read the following verses. Read them over again and reflect on each one. Memorize 2-3 of the verses below. God is forever faithful. His words stay true and his love never fails.

2 Timothy 2:13 If we are faithless, He remains faithful, for He cannot deny Himself.

Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful;

Psalms 100:5 For the LORD is good; His lovingkindness is everlasting And His faithfulness to all generations.

Psalms 33:4 For the word of the LORD is upright, And all His work is done in faithfulness.

1 Corinthians 4:2 In this case, moreover, it is required of stewards that one be found trustworthy.

Psalms 119:90 Your faithfulness continues throughout all generations; You established the earth, and it stands.

Psalms 117:2 For His lovingkindness is great toward us, And the truth of the LORD is everlasting. Praise the LORD!

Psalms 36:5 Your lovingkindness, O LORD, extends to the heavens, Your faithfulness reaches to the skies.

Matthew 25:23 "His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful slave. You were faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things; enter into the joy of your master.'

Psalms 91:4 He will cover you with His pinions, And under His wings you may seek refuge; His faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Isaiah 25:1 O LORD, You are my God; I will exalt You, I will give thanks to Your name; For You have worked wonders, Plans formed long ago, with perfect faithfulness.

Luke 16:10 "He who is faithful in a very little thing is faithful also in much; and he who is unrighteous in a very little thing is unrighteous also in much.
