Micah 5:2-5, Luke 1:1-4, Luke 2:1-20.

Questions For Discussion

Based on the prophecy of Micah 5:2-5 what are some of the things we learn about the Messiah?

- *Where will He come from? What will He accomplish? What is He described as?*

Micah was just one of the many prophecies regarding the birth of Christ. Luke was a first hand eye witness of the power of Christ. Together we are given some of the account of Jesus.

Based on Luke 1:1-4 what is Luke proclaiming about his account of the *STORY*?

- *Luke was determined to make sure his account of the Gospel would be accurate.*

Back to Luke 2:8-12. Look at the great announcement by the angel to the shepherds.

- *What was their immediate response?*

- *What was proclaimed?*

Soon thereafter the Angel is joined by who? (Luke 2:13-14)

- *Why was this such a big deal?*

- *No other announcement could ever be as big as this one? Why?*

What were the shepherds response? (Luke 2:15-17)

- *How much contemplation did they give to going and finding the baby?*

- *How would they know where to find Him?*

- *How did everyone respond to what they shared about their announcement?*

The Bottom Line

God used an angelic choir and gave a group of lowly shepherds front row seats to the greatest show of all times!

- Think about what this must have been like.
- How Mary and Joseph must have been encouraged by the visit of the shepherds!
- Mary pondered all of these things in her heart. Meaning she didn't want to miss a moment of God's grace towards her and the beginning of the greatest act of redemption the world would ever experience.
