Four Types Of Love

- Eros sensual or romantic love
- Philia brotherly love or friendship
- Storge the love between family members
- Agape highest most pure form of love that embodies selflessness by choice. Agape requires faithfulness, commitment, and sacrifice without expecting anything in return.

The Agape Chapter - The Description of the Love Of God
