

We are pleased to present the 2023-2024 year end report, highlighting the incredible work made possible through the dedication and generosity of our volunteers and supporters from July 2023 to June 2024. This year has been remarkable, with a total of \$488,812.30 in cash donations. In addition, we had 263 volunteers contribute a total of 5,933.50 hours of service, amounting to \$258,818.21 in non-cash donations. This amounts to a total year end contribution of \$747,630.51.

Project Highlights

Guyana - August 2023:

Our team undertook a Medical Missions and Humanitarian Aid trip to Guyana, involving thirteen volunteers. It was an amazing event called "The Table" where doctors and nurses helped women and girls. Several were healed after being prayed for by the medical team including one baby who presented as being brain dead, but the Lord healed her on the way to the hospital. Another lady who had cataracts was prayed for; she immediately went and washed her eyes and the cataract fell into her hand. We were thankful for the natural and supernatural Physician at work.

Algeria Refugee Camp - October 2023:

In October, two volunteers provided Humanitarian Aid in an Algerian refugee camp. They received an invitation to return to the camp after being a vital part of the religious delegations who met.

Israel Disaster Relief - December 2023:

In response to urgent needs, our team provided Disaster Relief and Humanitarian Aid in Israel. The team not only brought relief to the people of Israel but also were able to help soldiers and people in the West Bank. This strengthened the hand of our missionaries that are currently there. We also sent in funds to help two leadership families relocate when tensions were high.

Nicaragua - January 2024:

A nine-member team traveled to Nicaragua to provide Humanitarian Aid. They were able to help villages with food, school uniforms, and reading glasses. They also visited remote villages where they installed solar panels, providing electricity for light and sound systems for village churches.

Rwanda Serve Project - May 2024: Daystar Elementary School

In May, thirty-one volunteers, including members from AYC, CSi, and other groups, participated in a Serve Project in Rwanda. This project brought backpacks and supplies to 250 students. They were also given an invitation to attend a children's service, where forty-nine students received the Holy Spirit.

Brazil Serve Project - June 2024:

A significant effort was made in Brazil with seventy-eight volunteers, including CSi, AYC, and local volunteers. Over 250 students participated in a soccer camp. They received lunch and were able to attend a service where thirty-five received the Holy Spirit.

Dominican Republic Serve Project - June 2024:

In June, fifty-four volunteers, including missionaries and a group from Indiana, provided Humanitarian Aid in the Dominican Republic. The team went to two villages and had special services after giving bags of supplies to families who did not attend the church. Several connected with vital church leaders.

Fiji Serve Project - June 2024:

A team of fifty, including CSi, AYC, and local volunteers, provided Humanitarian Aid in Fiji. The team helped bring Humanitarian Aid to a village and also a local orphanage.

Additionally, we were able to send a CSi Team into an Access Challenged Nation recently. The team shared humanitarian aid and the love of Jesus with nearly three hundred families. Many of the individuals we served had never interacted with Christian believers previous to our efforts.

This year has been a testament to the power of collective effort and the impact of dedicated volunteers. We are deeply grateful for the continued support and commitment of our volunteers and donors. Their unwavering dedication has enabled us to reach and assist countless individuals in need, making a tangible difference in the lives of many.

Thank you for your partnership and support in these vital endeavors. We look forward to continuing our mission together, bringing hope and help to those in need around the world.
