Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus:

Compassion Service International (CSI) is pleased to present to you our July 1, 2016- June 30, 2017 activity report. This year has seen its share of disaster and suffering around the world and CSI has been privileged to respond to several crisis situations here in the United States and abroad.

Some of the places CSI has helped in 2016-2017 are:

- We continued to assist churches in Louisiana who suffered major damages during the flooding. We were also able to travel to Baton Rouge and hold a board member and have a special dinner for the pastors and their families who had been working tirelessly to give them a night of fellowship and encouragement.
- Funding was sent to assist flood victims in Nicaragua and Costa Rica to help with emergency food relief.
- Funding was sent to help 13 families in the Dominican Republic with flood relief by helping to purchase clothing and beds.
- We responded to the flooding in Peru with emergency food relief and building materials
- We assisted a family in Chile by purchasing building materials after their home was destroyed during the wildfires.
- In Georgia after a tornado caused widespread damage CSI was able to provide funding for a church to provide gift cards to families so that they could purchase personal items that had been lost.
- CSI has continued to fund the rebuilding of 4 churches in Haiti that were badly damaged during Hurricane Matthew and sent a team to North Carolina to assist hurricane victims.
- A food and medical relief effort was supported in South Sudan.
- Assistance was sent to Sri Lanka to assist 5 families whose homes were flooded
- The medical clinic in Liberia had suffered major roof damage and CSI was able to send the funding to repair the roof.
- CSI sent a disaster relief team and funding to assist earthquake victims in Ecuador
