Eurasia/Asia: *Lynden and Kathy Shalm*

Missionaries George and Margaret Shalm reared their son Lynden and his older brother, Allan, in India. After his Bible school training, Lynden Shalm pastored in Belleville and Beaverton, Ontario, and served as the Ontario District youth secretary for five years. He was the principal of the United



Pentecostal Bible Institute in Fredericton, New Brunswick, when he and his wife were appointed as missionaries to Sri Lanka and Pakistan in 1984. In Pakistan he served as the general secretary of the UPC in Pakistan, principal of New Life Training Center in Lahore, and supervisor for the Central District. He “worked very closely with the national leadership to press toward the goal of having the Pakistanis provide their own leadership and direction to the UPC of Pakistan.” He also conducted leadership and youth training seminars and preached crusades and evangelistic outreaches. In 2002, the UPCI’s General Board appointed Shalm as the regional director for the Asia Region. As the director, he oversees the entire Asian region and seeks to open new areas to the gospel.





*Prayer Points for
Bro. and Sis. Shalm:*

Pray for their relationship with God, spiritual rest, their faith, and overflow of the Spirit. “I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing” (John 15:5, ESV).

Pray for their physical well-being, health, safety, finances, and stamina in stressful conditions. “Finally, brothers, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may speed ahead and be honored, as happened among you, and that we may be delivered from wicked and evil men” (2 Thessalonians 3:1-2, ESV).

Pray for their emotional well-being, peace, joy, and hope that abounds. “Now may our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God our Father, who loved us and gave us eternal comfort and good hope through grace, comfort your hearts and establish them in every good work and word” (2 Thessalonians 2:16-17, ESV).

Pray for financial provision from God through faithful partners. “I have received full payment, and more. I am well supplied, having received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent, a fragrant offering, a sacrifice acceptable and pleasing to God” (Philippians 4:18, ESV).

Pray for their team’s effectiveness and unity. “So if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort from love, any participation in the Spirit, any affection and sympathy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind” (Philippians 2:1-2, ESV).

Pray for more workers to join them on the mission field. “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest” (Luke 10:2, ESV).

Pray for their local friendships, for open hearts, and transformed lives. “At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ” (Colossians 4:3, ESV).

Pray for the country, government, and the local people. “But seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the Lord on its behalf, for in its welfare you will find your welfare” (Jeremiah 29:7, ESV).

Prayer Points for Eurasia/Asia:

- Pray for the spiritually oppressed in remote areas to encounter the Gospel.
- Pray for the Church to multiply in the power of the Spirit as persecution intensifies.
- Pray for Christians in Asia who risk rejection from their families and social circles as well as from their homes by declaring that Jesus Christ is Lord. Many risk their very lives.
- Pray for strength, persistence, resilience and peace.
- Pray that believers will gain access to the Word of God.
- Pray that Christians are able to support and encourage one another in these countries.
- Pray for the hearts of people of the Muslim faith.
- Pray for protection against Islamic extremists in the Philippines and Indonesia.
- Thank God for the growth of the Church in Asia.
