HAITI: KE NAN KE ORPHANAGE

At *Ke Nan Ke Orphanage*, our mission outreach goes beyond just providing shelter. We've built two fully functioning children's home complexes, creating a safe and nurturing environment for orphaned children. Our impact extends to the broader community through a local school, English as a Second Language (ESL) classes, and a welcoming space where neighborhood children can come to play after school, including a soccer field.

In addition, we offer vital medical services through our on-site clinic, ensuring that both the children in our care and the surrounding community have access to healthcare. From education to healthcare and recreation, we are committed to transforming lives and giving children in Haiti the tools to build a brighter future.

LOVE HAS FEET: LITERACY IN WEST AFRICA



In partnership with Love Has Feet, CSI is addressing illiteracy, a major contributor to poverty in West Africa. Illiteracy limits access to jobs, healthcare, and basic necessities, but more importantly, it prevents individuals from accessing the Word of God.

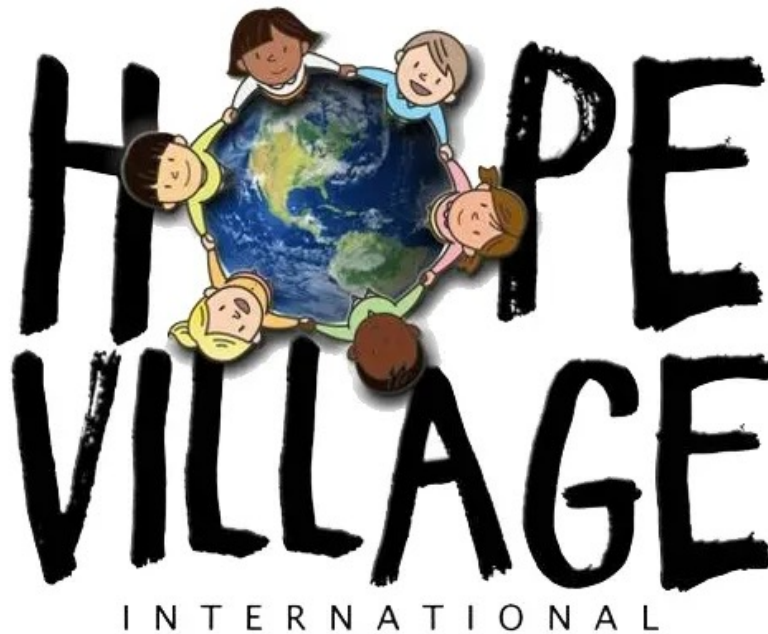
Love Has Feet uses a Bible-based literacy program, currently working with 6 languages to teach 289 students how to read and write. The program is led by 18 dedicated teachers and has already produced 213 graduates.

Beyond literacy, students receive essential items each week, including food (grain, vegetables), cloth, mosquito nets, and more, ensuring their holistic well-being as they learn.

THE PHILIPPINES: HOPE VILLAGE INTERNATIONAL

The children at The Village of Hope are survivors of extreme poverty, armed conflict, and natural disasters in one of the most disaster-prone regions in the world. Located on the tectonic plates, the Philippines is constantly at risk from typhoons, flooding, landslides, earthquakes, volcanoes, and droughts.

These orphaned and abandoned children are in survival mode, often spending their days searching for food and water, only to live in fear of it being stolen. Without intervention, they face little hope of an education or a future.

The Village of Hope provides these children with more than just the essentials of life. Their Christ-centered, church-driven programs offer nourishing food, a safe place to sleep, medical care, and access to education. Beyond physical needs, they focus on inner healing, showing each child that their life matters to us and to God. They have a purpose, and through holistic care, VOH helps them discover it.

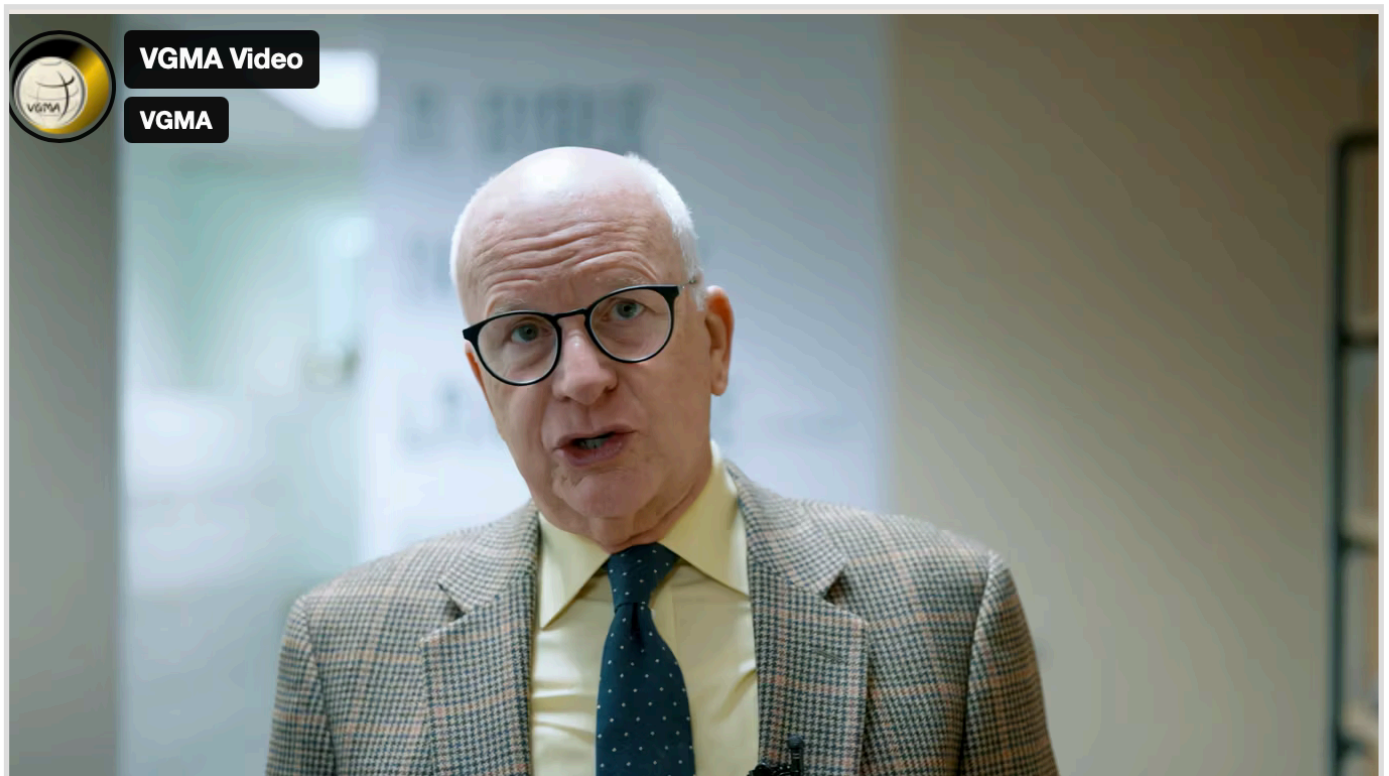

1. That they would continue to draw near to God daily in prayer and study of His Word.

Scripture:

“Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you.” James 4:8 (NKJV)

Prayer Point:

Lord, stir within them a deeper hunger for Your presence. May they daily seek You in prayer and in the study of Your Word, drawing closer to You with every passing day.

2. That they would have a spirit of thankfulness in all things.

Scripture:

“In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.”

1 Thessalonians 5:18 (NKJV)

Prayer Point:

Father, release a spirit of gratitude upon them, that in every circumstance — whether in lack or abundance, joy or trial — they would give thanks and glorify Your name.

3. That they would recognize their value in the body.

Scripture:

“But now indeed there are many members, yet one body... God has set the members, each one of them, in the body just as He pleased.”

1 Corinthians 12:20, 18 (NKJV)

Prayer Point:

Lord, open their eyes to see how precious and essential they are in the body of Christ. Let them move in confidence, knowing they are fearfully and wonderfully made with divine purpose.

4. That they would be intentional in mentoring the next generation for missions.

Scripture:

“And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.” **2 Timothy 2:2 (NKJV)**

Prayer Point:

Father, raise them up as faithful mentors and disciplers. May they intentionally pour into the next generation, igniting hearts for missions and kingdom work.

5. That God would supply all their needs, both financial and physical.

Scripture:

“And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.” — **Philippians 4:19 (NKJV)**

Prayer Point:

Jesus, the Lord who provides, meet every need in their life — financial, physical, emotional, and spiritual. Let them lack no good thing as they walk in obedience to You.
