



Missions Team Leader

Description: The Missions Team Leader, guided by a Christ-like spirit of service, oversees the planning, coordination, and execution of various missions and outreach activities within the church and the community. This role, rooted in faith and compassion, will be needed at the end of the spring to continue our mission of spreading God's love through acts of kindness and service.

Qualifications:

- A Member of Basehor United Methodist Church
- Demonstrated commitment to serving others with humility and grace.
- Strong organizational and leadership skills grounded in Christian principles.
- Ability to inspire and mobilize others to live out their faith through action.

Urgency: Position needed by the end of the spring to ensure a seamless transition and continued momentum in our mission efforts.



Lay Member of Annual Conference

Description: The Lay Member of Annual Conference, guided by the teachings of Christ, participates in the annual conference sessions, engaging in discussions and voting on legislation that reflects our Methodist values and beliefs. This individual, recognizing the spiritual significance of their role, serves as a conduit between our congregation and the broader

Methodist community. They report to the congregation after the close of the conference, sharing insights and decisions that impact our church's mission and ministry. Additionally, they serve as a member of the church council, finance committee, and staff/pastor-parish relations committee, contributing to the spiritual discernment and governance of our local church.

Travel: The Great Plains Annual Conference will be June 6-9, 2024, at the Younes Center in Kearney, Nebraska. Travel, Lodging, and Meals, are covered by the church. Spouses are welcome to attend too but will be listed as a "guest" at the conference and meals will not be reimbursed.

Qualifications:

- A member of Basehor United Methodist Church
- Deep-rooted faith and commitment to living out Methodist principles in daily life.
- Willingness to prayerfully consider and vote on matters affecting our church and denomination.

engagement. Through their leadership, they inspire others to draw closer to God and deepen their faith journey.

Qualifications:

- Authentic devotion to Christ and a passion for leading others in worship.
- Ability to articulate and convey the message of God's love with sincerity and conviction.

Urgency: Immediate need for volunteers to lead worship services with a heart for uplifting and encouraging the congregation in their faith.



Tech Team Lead

Description: Tech Team Lead, serving with a Christ-like spirit of excellence and humility, provides technical support and team leadership during church services and events, managing sound, lighting, and other audiovisual elements to enhance the worship experience. The tech lead, in partnership with the pastor designs and plans for audio-visual needs. Through their

service, they contribute to creating an environment where all can encounter God's presence. Training is provided.

Minimum Age: 12 Years Old.

Qualifications:

- Proficiency in operating audiovisual equipment with a servant's heart.
- Willingness to serve behind the scenes for the glory of God.

Urgency: Ongoing need for individuals to support the tech needs of the church, serving as vessels for God's work in our worship gatherings.

Ushers and Greeters

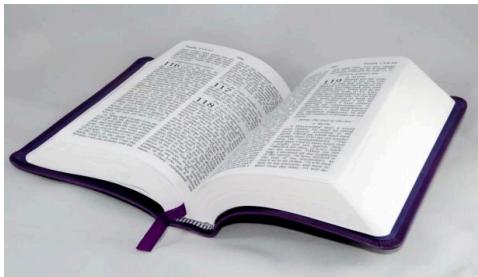

Qualifications:

Credo Bible Study Leader

Description: The Credo Bible Study Leader, rooted in Christ's teachings, volunteers for 1-2 Wednesdays a month to lead a Bible study at Credo Senior Living in Basehor, Kansas, from 2 pm to 3 pm. Study guides are provided, or they can

provide their own devotionals, fostering spiritual growth and fellowship among the residents.

Qualifications:

- A heart for sharing God's Word and encouraging spiritual growth in others.
- Ability to lead discussions with compassion, understanding, and respect for diverse perspectives.

Urgency: Ongoing need for volunteers to lead Bible studies and nurture the faith of seniors in our community.
