

Discovery Sunday Class Description

The Discovery Class is open to all adults. The class is made up of couples, singles, and spouses of people who are teaching other classes. Class participation is welcome, but no one is ever pressured to participate in discussion. The members of the Discovery Class like to explore various topics. We are not tied to a curriculum that dictates a schedule. We choose books and materials that interest us, and we work through each study at our own pace.

We recently studied the Apostles' Creed and The Lord's Prayer – phrase-by-phrase. Other subjects we have studied include the parables of Jesus, the writings of Desmond Tutu, a variety of topics using The Thoughtful Christian literature, and we took a critical look at the TV series titles "The Bible." Through several of Phillip Keller's books we have gained a better understanding of Jesus Christ as our Shepherd and of ourselves as His sheep as we learned more about the dedication, compassion, and love a shepherd has for his sheep.

This is a class where politics is left at the door, so no one is made to feel uncomfortable.

Our current and upcoming studies are publicized in the church bulletin and newsletter. People are welcome to come to this class for a particular study that appeals to them and then return to another Sunday School class, if they so desire. We look forward to you joining our class.

Current Study Guide: A Gardener Looks at the Fruits of the Spirit by W. Phillip Keller.

The class has studied several books by this layman and found them easy from which to glean how we can walk closer to God. Part 1 of this book is based on the parable of the sower and the types of soil/hearts of humans. Part 2 looks at the Fruits of the Spirit as named in 1 Cor. 13 and Galatians 5.
