As you can see from the above Loan Status, the new balance of our building loan is \$370,000. A sizable payment was made when the terms were renegotiated which reduced the amount we had to borrow. Our new term is 5 years at a rate of 4.75%. While this resulted in a lower required monthly payment, we feel that being good stewards of the church's money, we are going to continue to make the previous higher payment to further reduce the balance quicker. This, coupled along with the capital campaign proceeds being applied monthly, will result in an even quicker loan payoff. This is exciting news and we appreciate everyone's contributions to the capital campaign and helping us become debt free!
