FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

Q. What is the Parent and Child Camp?

A. The Parent and Child camp is an overnight event for children who are in Kindergarten-3rd grade (and their parents). The purpose of this camp is to give these children a chance to experience worship services designed specifically for them, participate in learning activities with their parents, as well as to allow them to have fun. We will be spending the night at Camp Macoba in New Market, AL. Lodging is divided by gender with two bunk houses or you may tent or RV camp.

Q. What activities are involved in this Parent and Child camp?

A. You can see the attached schedule for all activities. Basically, the weekend will include large group worship time, parent/child activity time, game time, and meal time.

Q. How much does the Parent and child camp cost?

A. Cost is \$30 per person. (\$60 for one child and one adult) and includes t-shirts, food, lodging and crafts. Additional adults are \$30 each.

Q. What do we need to bring?

A. twin bedding or sleeping bag, pillow, beauty/hygiene items, towels and wash clothes, appropriate sleepwear, clothes for Saturday, Bible, and pencil/pens.

Q. Must parents participate?

A. Because of the age group involved in this activity, each child must bring their own chaperone. Parents need to model good behavior and participate in all of the activities. Make this a special weekend for you and your child.

Q. Can my child invite someone else to come?

A. Your child may invite any of their friends (in K-3rd grade) to participate in the Parent and Child Camp, but each child needs to bring a chaperone (or you agree to be their parent for the weekend.) **Everyone must be signed up by November 4.** We have to order t-shirts and buy food ahead of time, so we must have a final number by November 5. Q. How will the children be traveling to camp?

A. We will ask you to drive you and your child to camp. Directions: Coming from Huntsville, head North on Winchester Road. Go through downtown New Market AL. Once you cross the bridge as you leave New Market, turn left at the first road you come to (Hillsboro Circle)....about a mile. You will go around one curve and Hillsboro Drive is the first road on your left. Follow it until you run out of pavement, then keep following the gravel road into the campground
