

Living in the In-Betweens

Acts 1:12-26

All these with one accord were devoting themselves to prayer. Acts. 1:14a

1) Prayer

Is my life a life devoted to prayer?

2) Prophecy

In the times of upheaval, do I trust in the promises of God?

3) Picking

When an important decision is made, do I submit to God-given authority?

So what? As I think about what we studied here today, how am I able to answer this question: In the in-betweens of my life, am I devoting myself to prayer, trusting in God, and submitting to His will in my life?

Small Group Questions

1) Prayer

The disciples came down from Mount Olivet and immediately gathered to pray. What were they praying for? Acts 1:7-8 might give a clue. Notice the list of names in verses 13 and 14. Why do you think Luke listed these names and in the order they are listed?

2) Prophecy

Peter is leading a meeting of 120 people. The meeting starts with addressing the prophecies in Scripture around the death of Judas. Why is this topic the first to be addressed in the meeting? Notice how Peter used prophecy in the Psalms to show that the betrayal and death of Judas was not a mistake. What comfort do these fulfilled prophecies give to the group?

3) Picking

Peter now moves to the next order of business to find a replacement for Judas. What are the criteria for Judas's replacement? Why are these requirements important? Read the prayer in verse 24. What stands out to you in that prayer? Read Exodus 28:30. What can we learn from the apostles casting lots for the replacement of Judas?
