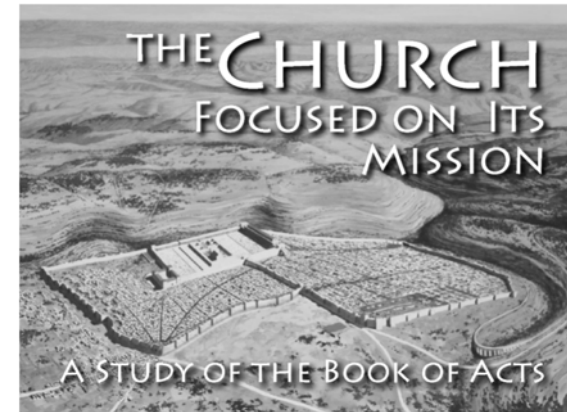

Small Group Questions

1. Lessons from the life of Simon

Acts 8:9-25

What caused Simon to respond to the power of the Spirit in the manner he did? What can we learn from this response? What can we learn from Peter's response to Simon? What can we learn from Simon's request for Peter to pray for him?

2. Lessons from the life of the Ethiopian eunuch

Acts 8:26-38

Philip was given a divine appointment to share the gospel. Share a time when you were given a divine appointment to share the gospel. What happened and what was the outcome? Read Isaiah 53:7-8 and talk about how Philip might have used this Scripture as a starting point for explaining Jesus.

3. Lessons from the life of Philip

Acts 9:9-40

How was Philip led by the Spirit in his interactions with the Ethiopian eunuch? How does the Spirit communicate with us concerning divine appointments to share the truth of the gospel?

4. Pray as a group that God would give you more divine appointments to share the truth.

So what? As I think about what we studied here today, how am I able to answer this question: *Am I open to the Spirit's leading in my life to share the gospel?*
