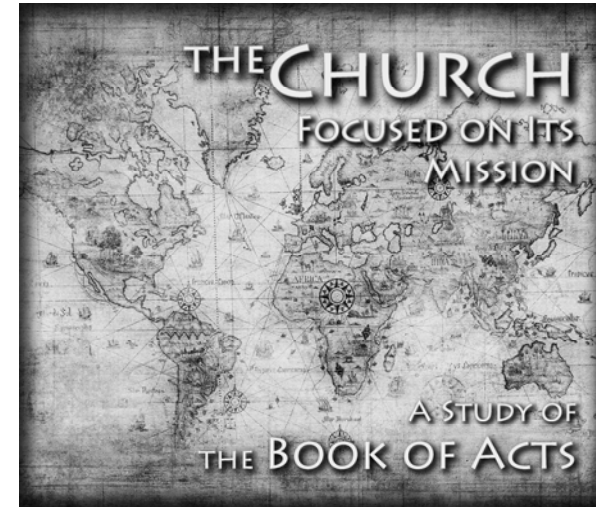

God's power for the Church to fulfill its mission and sustain it amid persecution is the Holy Spirit, who must be sought earnestly through prayer.

Lead On, Holy Spirit!

Acts 12:25 - 13:5

The Holy Spirit leads us on.

- 1) We get to learn from the Holy Spirit. Acts 12:25-13:1

How are you seeking the Holy Spirit's direction? Who are your teachers?

- 2) We get to hear the Holy Spirit. Acts 13:2

What active steps do you need to take to hear the Holy Spirit's direction?

- 3) We get to follow the Holy Spirit. Acts 13:3-5

Are you following the Holy Spirit's direction obediently?

So, what? As I think about what we studied here today, how am I able to answer this question: *What one thing do I need to change to jump on board with the Holy Spirit?*

Small Group Questions

The Holy Spirit leads us on.

- 1) **We get to learn from the Holy Spirit.** Acts 12:25-13:1
Please read Acts 11:19-30 out loud to remind yourselves of this special congregation in Antioch. When we studied this passage, we saw that God works powerfully in and through a community devoted to Him. That is what the community in Antioch was. In the passage for today, Luke gives more detail on how they sought and responded to the Spirit's leading. Please reread the overall theme that we are remembering as we look at the book of Acts together: **God's power for the Church to fulfill its mission and sustain it amid persecution is the Holy Spirit, who must be sought earnestly through prayer.** This passage we are looking at this week is especially helpful to show us how we as a church can seek the Lord's leading as we focus on our mission to know Christ and make Him known. Notice the list of prophets and teachers. These were men of God who were gifted by the Holy Spirit to teach and exhort. Apparently, these five men were uniquely gifted to guide the church of Antioch into the Holy Spirit's truth. The church in Antioch has been learning under empowered leaders. Consider the first few verses of the passage. What relationship do you think these five men had with each other? What relationship do you think they may have had with the Lord? How would that have influenced their teaching? How do you think their teaching influenced the church in Antioch? Talk about times in your life when you have been influenced to know the Lord more through teaching. How has that impacted you?
- 2) **We get to hear the Holy Spirit.** Acts 13:2
While these men were ministering to the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit spoke to them and gave them direction! The word that is translated worship in many translations is actually the word "leitourgeō". It gives us the word "liturgy". It is found only a couple of times in Scripture. Another time is in Hebrews 10:11. There it is translated as "performs his religious duties." So we see that worship is much more than singing, even though that is what it is thought of many times in our culture. Talk about the ways that you worship. How does it impact you to think of worship as ministering to the Lord? Fasting is a "voluntary abstinence from food for a spiritual purpose" according to Donald Whitney. Talk about fasting in your group. Have any of you ever fasted? How has it drawn you closer to the Lord? How does fasting and ministering to the Lord set the stage for the Holy Spirit to lead and direct? God leads through His Word. Talk about a time in your life that God spoke to you through His Word and directed your path.
- 3) **We get to follow the Holy Spirit.** Acts 13:3-5
Notice carefully how the direction of the Holy Spirit was followed. What steps do you see in 13:3-5? What happened after the Holy Spirit gave direction? There are four things that occurred in verse 3. Do you see them? What does that tell you about how the church in Antioch had learned to follow the Holy Spirit's leading? How hard do you think it may have been to send off two of the main teachers? What do you suppose was the atmosphere as the men were sent away? How will we view this type of situation if we realize that we are only part of a global, eternal plan? How often do you think about what God may be doing to grow His message through you? What do you think the church is here for? Talk about that in your group. What is the mission of the church? How does it impact your day to day life? Are we ready to train and release people regularly to the ministry that they have been called? It could be to the far reaches of the earth, or it could be to their workplace.
- 4) **Consider the "so what" question of the week.**
Share your answer. Pray for each other!
