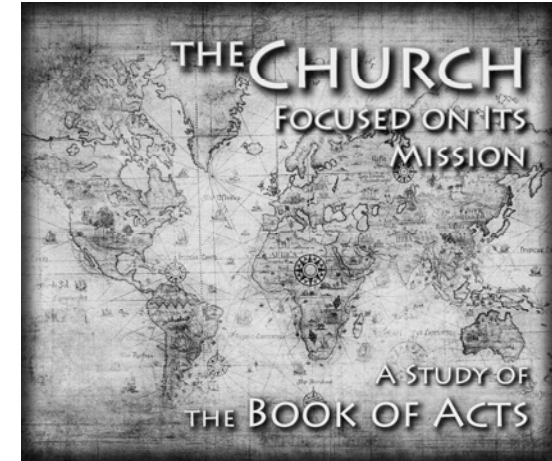


### The Telecoil... Connecting Directly to Sound

God's power for the Church to fulfill its mission and sustain it amid persecution is the Holy Spirit, who must be sought earnestly through prayer.

## God's Guidance

Acts 15:36-16:10

God guides His followers.

- 1) God guides His followers to strengthen each other. Acts 15:36-41

So what? Do I have that internal desire to strengthen other believers?

- 2) God guides His followers to each other. Acts 16:1-5

So what? Am I open to ministry with those God places in my life?

- 3) God guides His followers through open and closed doors. Acts 16:6-10

So what? Are we willing to be guided by the Spirit?

## Small Group Questions

God guides His followers.

- 1) God guides His followers to strengthen each other.  
Paul desires to go and visit the brothers in every city where they had proclaimed the Word of God. Read Romans 1:8-15. What are the reasons he wants to visit Rome? From this passage in Romans, what can we learn about the reasons for this second trip? Conflict arises over bringing Mark along on the trip. Paul thinks they should not and Barnabas thinks they should. What can we learn about Paul and Barnabas during this conflict, as well as their unique calling in life? Read 1 Corinthians 9:6. Barnabas worked with Mark, and Mark and Paul were restored. What can this teach us about restoration of fellow believers?
- 2) God guides His followers to each other.  
God guided Paul directly to Timothy at the beginning of this trip. Share a time where God guided you to a person that greatly impacted your spiritual life. Paul circumcised Timothy so as not to be a stumbling block to the Jewish believers. How can we remove stumbling blocks in our culture as we proclaim the gospel truth? Notice Paul's desire to bring others with him in his trips. What can we learn from Paul's examples? Share a time when someone discipled you in your spiritual journey. Pray that God would give you *burden, opportunity, and boldness* to disciple others.
- 3) God guides His followers through opening and closing doors.  
How did Paul handle unexpected change in his ministry? What can we learn from Paul's response? Share a time when God closed a door for you. Share a time when God opened a door for you that was previously closed.
