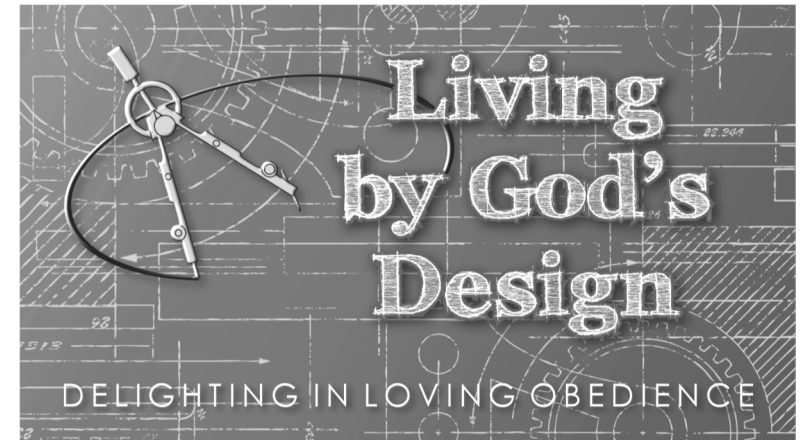


### The Telecoil... Connecting Directly to Sound

Delighting in Loving Obedience

God’s Design for Truth (Part 3)

Psalm 119:33-40

The Word of God is our guide to true life—and our authority.

- 1) Delight is found on the path of the Word.

*Direct me in the path of your commands, for there I find delight.* 119:35

- 2) The Word renews the heart and mind—changes the authority—for right living.

*Teach me, give me understanding, direct me, turn my heart, turn my eyes, fulfill your promise, take away*

FOUR SOURCES OF AUTHORITY

taken from *Survival Kit*, by Ralph Neighbour, Lifeway Press

Sources inside yourself

You determine truth by your ability to reason what is right or wrong, good or bad, and so on.

You determine truth by your senses, feelings, and emotions.

Sources outside yourself

You structure your beliefs by those which have been important to your ancestors.

God reveals His truth in written form. That truth is your final, ultimate authority.

*See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ.* Colossians 2:8

- 3) A renewed mind longs for more of God’s Word.

*How I long for your precepts!  
In your righteousness preserve my life.* 119:40

**So, what?** As I think about what we studied here today, how am I able to answer these questions: *What is the real source of authority for my life? What steps do I need to take to have God, as He has revealed His truth, be my source of authority?*

Small Group Questions

The Word of God is our guide to true life—and our authority.

We each grow up in a culture. Every person of every time has faced that same reality. God determines when and where each person will live (Acts 17:26). Every culture creates a filter that we look through and our thoughts are shaped by that culture in a very real way. Paul speaks to this when he urges the Romans to be transformed from thinking in a worldly way by renewing their minds so as to think correctly—have a biblical worldview. It is critical that if a follower of Jesus wants their mind renewed, that they look to the Bible, allowing the Bible to become the authority in their life. We live in a culture that has been impacted by post-modernism, feminism, humanism, secularism, and the sexual revolution, just to name a few. Media has transformed the mind of the culture, instead of the Bible transforming the culture. Most Christians do not realize how these alternate worldviews as promoted through the media have become an authority in their lives because it is so subtle. It has influenced the way we think. We make every decision of our life through the lens of our worldview. If that worldview has been shaped and molded by the culture, we will make a cultural decision. If it has been renewed by the power of the word of God, we will make decisions with an eternal perspective and a right mind.

- 1) **Delight is found in the path of the Word.**

What are the ways that you find delight in the path of the commands of God? Talk about where you find delight. How many times do you go elsewhere for entertainment (delight)? What are some of the struggles you have with allowing the word of God to be your delight? When are some times that you have found your delight in the word?

- 2) **The Word renews the heart and mind—changes the authority—for right living.**

Talk about the four sources of authority and how you have found them to have an influence in your life. How have the three inferior sources of authority guided you in past decisions. Are there times you can see that you were guided into incorrect thinking or decisions because of these influences? How does having Scripture as your authority guide you to right decisions? How does it give you boldness as you claim that authority?

- 3) **A renewed mind longs for more of God’s Word.**

Once you begin to realize the power and freedom and delight that is found in living under the authority and with the power of the authority of the word you will long for more. Like the psalmist you will desire the word of God more and more. Talk about the ways that you have found this to be true in your life. If you have not found it to be true, talk about how you can begin to look into God’s Word intentionally to find this delight! Set goals and hold each other accountable.

- 4) **Consider the “So what?” question of the week.**

Are there any thoughts you would like to share with the group?
