So, what? As I think about what we studied here today, how am I able to answer these questions: *Is Jesus your King? How can you respond to Him with the worship He is due today... and every day?*

Small Group Questions

For added perspective, read Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:28-44; and John 12:12-19.

- 1) **Jesus is the sovereign King.** **Matthew 21:1-5**
Take some time to set the scene in your mind, and look at the passages above to help you do that. What are some things that stand out to you about how this account unfolds? What is the evidence of Jesus' sovereignty over all things, both in this week's text and in the fulfillment of the prophetic word from Zechariah 9:9? Take a few moments to read that verse from Zechariah. What do you see in that prophecy that wasn't included in the gospel writers' accounts? Why is that significant?

- 2) **Jesus is the King of the Jews.** **Matthew 21:6-9**
How did the crowd, at least in this moment, acknowledge Jesus as King? "Hosanna" means "save now." The cries of this Jewish crowd echo Psalm 118. Take some time to look over this psalm, especially verses 22-29. As a Messianic psalm, how do these verses point ahead to their fulfillment in Jesus? In what ways do you think the crowds understood the salvation King Jesus was bringing? In what ways might they have misunderstood it? In what ways does this happen today?

- 3) **Jesus is our King.** **Matthew 21:10-11**
While this is a scene of Jesus coming to the Jews as their Messiah, His completed work on the cross and the invitation of the gospel is now for all people, Jew and Gentile. The messages from the past few weeks have been in Ephesians. How do the first two chapters of Ephesians help you see how Jesus is King for the Jew and for the Gentile? How can you answer the person who looks at the person and work of Jesus and, like the crowds in Matthew 21:10, asks "Who is this?" How does your understanding of Jesus the King lead you to respond to Him with the worship He is due?

- 4) **Consider the "So what?" questions from this week.**
As you reflect on those questions and the message as a whole, do you have any other thoughts to share with the group?
