## Responsibilities:

### **Prior to Camp:**

- Oversee Camp Staff during camp season and be part of hiring process
- Oversee the planning and preparation of weekly themed camp activities with the help of Assistant Director (AD)
- Manage camp budgets with the help of Pastor of Faith Formation
- Schedule volunteers to help throughout the summer (volunteer counsellors, bus drivers, teachers, etc)
- Prepare gospel-centric devotions for campers each morning including a theme for the week
- Work with your team to coordinate games/activities for SERVE 2025
- Be in contact with camp families with relevant information
- Shopping for needed materials
- Complete required paperwork from Canadian Summer Jobs Grant
- Other duties as assigned by Pastor of Faith Formation

#### **During Camp:**

- Interact with parents during check in/out
- Lead group games and activities and ensure weekly themes permeate throughout camp
- Provide leadership and support for fellow staff during games and activities
- Lead daily devotions for campers
- Lead daily meetings/devotions with staff and volunteers
- Engage with children during various activities
- Organize and facilitate weekly Friday Family Feast's
- Solving any needs or concerns of campers or camp parents
- Work with Pastor of Faith Formation to ensure budgets are kept
- Ensure that upcoming activities are ready for campers by the time they arrive
- Ensure areas used for camp are cleaned up at the end of each day
- Document footage to be used in promotional materials
- Demonstrate Christ like qualities during and outside of camp hours
- Other duties as assigned by Pastor of Faith Formation
