
#### The Nail as a Symbol of Redemption: (hand each one their 3rd nail)

#### The Wire as a Manifestation of God's

**Grace:** (hand everyone a piece of wire. Following the reading, have them assemble the cross - see picture. Make sure that create a hoop for the leather strap)



The story of the nails ultimately reveals the boundless grace of our loving Heavenly Father. Despite our unworthiness, God extended His mercy and grace through Jesus' sacrifice. Just as the nails held Jesus to the cross, God's grace (the wire) holds us in His loving embrace. It is by His grace that we are forgiven, cleansed, and empowered to live a life that reflects His love to the world. The wire that we use to fasten the nails together reminds us of our need for His redemption through His Grace.

# The Leather Rope of Unending love (give each one a piece of leather rope, make sure it is long enough. Following the reading have them fasten it to the cross)

The love of God is immeasurable, unmistakable, and unending. It is without beginning and without end. Nothing we can ever do, or will ever do, can stop Him from loving us. His love for us is unending, unfailing, and unconditional. It was the love of God that sent Jesus Christ to the cross, and no matter what sin we have committed, God loves us. Just as this leather rope is circular - no beginning or end when tied to the cross, so is God's love for You!

# The blessing of the Crucifixion (You, as leader, place around their neck)

The cross was a cruel form of torture, a brutal way to die but it became a symbol of life for you and for me. It is only through the cross that we are 100% forgiven for our sin and made right with God through the horrific death of Jesus. There is no other way but through the blood of the cross. As I place this necklace around your neck today, know the power of the cross for your life, know the unending love that God has for you. So receive these words and believe them to be true for you...
