STAFF MEMBER STATEMENT OF BELIEFS
AND CODE OF CONDUCT**

1. *I believe* that as a staff member, I represent Moline Christian School everywhere I go.
2. *I believe* that God is one, eternally existent in three persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.
3. *I believe* that this triune God has revealed himself in a general way in his world and universe, and in more specific ways in the divinely inspired and infallible Bible, the history of creation, and redemption through Jesus Christ.
4. *I believe* that the home, church, and school should complement each other in promoting children's spiritual, academic, social, and physical growth.
5. *I believe* that God has given parents the ultimate responsibility to nurture and educate their children.
6. *I believe* that the teacher in school stands in the place of the parents.
7. *I believe* that God has given differing abilities to all students and that it is the teacher's responsibility to challenge these children according to their abilities and to teach them at their developmental levels.
8. *I believe* that Christian students are not to be conformed to this world but are to be transformed by the renewing of their minds to live out their lives in obedience to God, according to his will revealed in the Bible.
9. *I believe* that the student's home, church, and school experiences should enable them to live lives of meaningful service as citizens of the kingdom of God on earth.
10. *I believe* that Moline Christian School shall meet the academic standards of the State of Michigan in respect to academic certifications and basic curriculum to enable students to contribute to the general welfare of the State and society in which they live.
11. *I believe* that parents who are Christian, are active members and regular worshipers in an orthodox Christian church, and agree to have their children instructed according to Reformed Christian standards, may have their children enrolled in Moline Christian School.
